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Example of Classroom Workshops

Workshops will be based on collaboration with school. Possible workshops could include the following:

- 1) Fall workshop: focus on developing relationships with others while learning the song “We’re Friends”. Discussions would invite the students to offer ideas on:
 - Recognizing feelings in others and self
 - How to use words to express need and feelings
 - Showing compassion for others
 - Working cooperatively on a project

The workshop could include an art project based on the song, a different song or one the students develop based on a familiar song. The art project could be done in small or large groups, as individual work or as a class book.

- 2) Winter workshop: focus on winter activities including :
 - “Let’s Make Snowmen” and “Run, Little Snowmen”:sing songs, do movement activity, create art activity
 - “Winter Tree”: Read book, sing song using bells and develop art project to create a winter tree in the classroom

- 3) Spring workshop:
 - “Little Robin Redbreast”: read book, sing song, create nest props for students to use while singing song
 - Pond song: read book [Around the Pond](#) and create classroom pond book with each child’s picture. Create pond creatures to use in singing the song.
